3RD TERM, 2018/2019

1. **SCHOOL RE-OPENING:** The school re-opened for the 3rd term on the 29th of April, 2019 with a Holy Mass in the school chapel to thank God for bringing us back safely after the Easter holiday. We launched into the school programmes immediately.
2. **2019/2020 ADMISSIONS:** Admissions into the school for the 2019/2020 academic session have been concluded. We offer words of welcome to these students and their parents in our midst. The sales of admission forms for 2020/2019 academic year will commence on November 1, 2019. The next admission exam will be a single exam on March 7, 2020.
3. **2019 CAREER WEEK/EDUCATION FOR LIFE FOR JSS 3 STUDENTS:** The annual Career Week/Education for Life for all JSS 3 students took place between June 11, 2019 and 18, 2019. During this programme, professionals from all walks of life were invited to talk to the children on Career choices, academic requirements for entry into such careers as well as job prospects that exist in such areas. Immediately this was concluded, the second phase of the programme tagged **Education for Life** commenced. Prior to these programmes the JS3 students had internship/work-experience followed by professional diagnostic placement test.
4. **SCHOOL CARDINAL PROGRAMMES:** We wish to once again bring to the attention of parents the five **cardinal programmes of this school which every student must undergo before he/she can graduate from here.** These are;
 - A. **Internship** for JS3 in preparation for choosing subjects in senior classes and “Career Week” where they are professionally guided to determine their future careers.
 - B. **Citizenship and Leadership Training** programme for all SS 1 students with evidence of successful completion,
 - C. **Service Programme** for all SS 2 students with evidence of successful completion from the centre. This is a school of the heart.
 - D. **Emmaus Retreat** for all SS 3 students at the end of 1st term examination in December and
 - E. **Grad at Grad** for all graduating SS 3 students after their WAEC examinations.

Any student who fails to participate successfully in any of these activities cannot graduate from St. Francis until such a student repeats the said programme and be cleared.

5. **STUDENT-ADMINISTRATORS' DAY:** On May 27, 2019 students held sway in the school as administrators for one day. On that day, students worked as the School Administrator, Deputy Administrator, Head Teachers, Assistant Head Teachers and Teaching as well as non-teaching staff. Most of the students in SS 2 took over the staff rooms as subject teachers. Some students worked as security staff, kitchen staff, and clinic staff, to mention but a few. Also, JSS 2 students took over as prefects and school functionaries for that day. It was very interesting seeing students trying out what their teachers have been doing over the years. For us, this is *a way of training the children in leadership*.
- 6a. **2019 GRADUATION CEREMONY:** The 2019 graduation ceremony for SS 3 students was held on July 20, 2019. Prior to the graduation, the students went through a three-day pre-graduation retreat, **Graduate at Graduation" [GRAD AT GRAD]**, which prepared these students to face the challenges of life after secondary school. The graduation ceremony was a very colourful event which parents and guests attended in their numbers. Prizes and certificates were also presented to deserving students. The Provincial of The North-West Africa Province of the Society of Jesus, Very Rev. Fr. Chuks A. Afiawari, SJ was represented by Rev. Fr. Chikere Ugwuanyi, S.J. as the presider of the graduation Mass. Following the Mass was the blessing of the new e-Library, which is equipped with 50 computers powered by 18 new solar panels fixed at the South-East section of the roof. The Guest Speaker of this year's ceremony was Godwin Nwabunka, Ph.D. Prior to the graduation ceremony, the graduating students had a treat of a sumptuous graduation dinner in the Loyola Jesuit Jubilee Building on Thursday, the July 18, 2019.
- 6b. **SPECIAL ANNOUNCEMENT:** During the graduation Mass, Fr. Provincial announced through his Socius Fr. Chikere Ugwuanyi, S.J. that the Deputy Administrator Fr. Chikere Agbo, S.J. is being missioned to South Africa for tertianship. A new Deputy Administrator will take over from Fr. Agbo in September, next academic year. He is Rev. Ignatius Idoko, S.J. We thank Fr. Agbo for the great service he has given to St. Francis for six years. We welcome Rev. Idoko, who will be ordained a priest with 8 other Jesuits in Benin City on July 27.
7. **2019 CITIZENSHIP AND LEADERSHIP TRAINING:** The 2019 Citizenship and Leadership Training at the Apapa Sea School will commence on the July 21, 2019. Participation is mandatory for all students currently in SS 1 in the 2018/2019 academic session. Each student has been given a list of items expected at the centre. Parents are enjoined to discourage their children from carrying unnecessary luggage to the camp. Each student is expected to travel with a **Medical Fitness Certificate issued by a qualified Medical Doctor**. To ensure the credibility of the medical report of our students, the school has undertaken to organize the medical assessment as well as obtain the certificate and the bill goes to the parents. Parents who may wish to visit their children will be free to do so on Sunday the July 28, 2019. If any parent has any need to see the child outside the official date of Sunday July 29, such a parent will need to collect a letter of authorization from the school before embarking on such trip. **Please note that all students will take off from the school here on the 22nd by 6:00 A.M. and return here on the 31st July. They should be picked up between 3:00 P.M. and 5:00 P.M.**
8. **2019 SERVICE PROGRAMME:** The 2019 Service Programme for all SS 2 students will commence on July 23, 2019 with missioning mass at 10:00 A.M. This programme is compulsory for all affected students. Each student is expected to render humanitarian

service working eight (8) hours a day. We are using this medium to appeal to parents to support our efforts in producing men and women for others. Please ensure that your ward follows the programme to the letter. We have taken necessary precautions to make the programme hitch-free. Some of the students will reside at their various places of service while others will work from their respective homes. Letters indicating the centre of student have been sent to parents/guardians. Kindly fill the form attached to your ward's placement letter and return to the director of the service programme by July 23. The service programme ends on August 3. The welcoming Mass followed by collection of results by SS2 is on August 4 by 10:00am. Please support your child/ward and the school with donations of foodstuff, baby clothes, and cash that shall be sent to the centres.

9. **3RD TERM RESULTS FOR SS 1 AND SS 2 STUDENTS:** Please note that SS 1 and SS 2 students have not completed this academic session. The results for SS1 students are released after the Leadership Training while those of the SS2 are collected after the service programme. Participation in these programmes, together with good academic performance, is a requirement for promotion to the next class.
10. **BROADENING AND DEEPENING STUDENT LEADERSHIP:** In order to broaden and deepen leadership formation in St. Francis, the Student Representative Council (SRC), Student Judicial Council (SJC) and the Student Executive Council (SEC—Prefects) are being entrusted with more responsibility. This broadening of leadership gives the students a sense of praxis in the government theories they learn from books and the classroom.
11. **APPROVED CALCULATORS:** In order to be in sync with WAEC standards, the approved calculators for students are the WAEC Approved Calculators. Parents are advised to purchase these from the Alumni Bookshop. From next session, any calculator that does not conform with the above specification will not be allowed in the school.
12. **GOOGLE SCHOOL AND ONLINE SUMMER COACHING:** St. Francis became a Google School in June 2019. We now have the Google G-Suite for Education. We plan to have online summer coaching this holiday from August 5, 2019 to August 30, 2019. Registration is 10K for each student. The online lessons will be taught by teachers of SFCSS in order to prepare our students for their next class level. We want our children to have a head-start. Ensure you register your child.
13. **FARMLAND:** The school is developing a newly acquired one plot of farmland for crop and animal farming. This is being anchored by the Agricultural Science Department. We want to equip our children with better agricultural knowhow and praxis.
14. **JESUIT ANNUAL FESTIVAL OF DRAMA, ART EXHIBITION, MUSIC, AND CULTURE:** The Annual Jesuit Festival of Drama, Art Exhibition Music and Culture will feature for the second time in St. Francis on the 1st of October, 2019. It is a day set aside to relax and enjoy the beautiful talents that God has blessed our children with. All parents are invited for it promises to be fun-filled.
15. **APPLICATIONS FOR VISA FOR INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL:** We wish to once more remind the parents that the school does not approve or release students for visa appointments during the session, Service Programmes, Sea School, and school retreats. Parents are advised not to book International Passport and visa interviews during the school session. Please consult our Students Handbook and Planner to see when such window is provided. Make use of holidays and mid-term breaks for such exercises.

- 16. AMERICAN COLLEGE TEST (ACT) CENTRE:** In partnership with the Education U.S.A., St. Francis Catholic Secondary School is now an ACT Centre and prepares interested SS2 students for the ACT examination. Our maiden ACT Test in SFCSS was on June 8, 2019. It is a one-day exam. ACT measures a student's achievement in core academic areas important for their university career in the United States or Canada—namely—English, Mathematics, Reading, Science, and (optionally) writing. It is not a mandatory exam in SFCSS. It is optional for parents to register their children, and it comes with a fee.
- 17. INTERNATIONAL GENERAL CERTIFICATE OF SECONDARY EDUCATION (IGCSE)** IGCSE is an English language curriculum offered to students to prepare them for various higher educational pursuits. It was developed by University of Cambridge International Examinations. The local provider in Nigeria is the British Council, Lagos and there are two series in the world, May/June series and October/November series. St. Francis takes the October/November series because of our schedule of academic activities. After indication of interest by parents of SS3 students (current SS2 students), the students for this exam are specially selected by St. Francis based on academic merit. IGCSE also comes with a fee.
- 18. JAMB/UTME:** We thank God for the success of our SS3 students in the UTME/JAMB examination of 2019. They smashed records and made the best JAMB result in the history of the school. The Eagles of 2019 recorded the highest score of 334 in the school. One hundred and one (101) students scored in the range of 250 to 334 in JAMB, and nine of these scored 300 and above. The range of scores from 200 to 249 had 49 students. No student scored lower than 200.
- 19. JESUIT PRIESTLY ORDINATION:** We are pleased to announce the priestly ordination of nine deacons on July 27, 2019 by 10:00 A.M. at St. Joseph Catholic Church Benin City. Please remember them in your prayers. It is the biggest Jesuit ordination in the history of the province.
- 20. 2019 MASS OF THE HOLY SPIRIT/PRIZE GIVING DAY:** The annual Mass of the Holy Spirit/Prize-Giving Day ceremony for the 2019/2020 academic session will hold on **Friday, 4th of October, 2019**. This is a day set aside by the school to officially commence the academic year and commit all our activities into the hands of the Holy Spirit. It is also a day for appreciating the gifts of the Holy Spirit in our individual and collective lives. Students and staff who have excelled in the previous session are rewarded for their excellent performances. Usually, parents and friends of the school sponsor the awards through generous donations. We appeal to parents to support this programme through generous donations of cash, academic materials, computers and lap-tops, books, etc for the winners.
- 21. 2019 ANNUAL INTER-HOUSE SPORTS COMPETITION:** The 2019/2020 school annual inter-house sports competition comes up on the **16th of November, 2019** in the school's sports bowl. Parents already know their houses and new parents will be assigned to houses before the sports competition. Parents are to sponsor their houses as well as take part in the activities of their houses including competitions on behalf of their wards' houses. We shall be relying on parents for the donation of medals as usual. A total of 325 medals in Gold, Silver and Bronze will be required. Kindly assist us in any way you can.
- 22. NEW JESUIT REGENT:** We welcome Br. Uche Oguike, S.J. as he commences his mission at St. Francis Catholic Secondary School Idimu, Lagos.

23. XAVIER SPORTS FIESTA: On Wednesday, July 17, 2019 SFCSS had the maiden edition of the Xavier Sports Fiesta. There were interschool competitions in soccer, basketball, and volleyball in the bowl of SFCSS. Some parents came to support the Eagles.
